Please note the self-study caps have been removed and all hour deficiencies for the late compliance period and all hour deficiencies for the 2018-2019 biennium can be completed by self-study or live interactive webinars. Failure to submit all requested documents and fees by the deadline will subject you to sanction and/or suspension from the practice of law by the Commission on Continuing Legal Education, in accordance with Gov. Bar R. X, Section 17, and CCLE Regulation 503. In addition to making up your deficient hours by June 29, you must also submit your Late Compliance Reporting Form (Form 19) **postmarked** no later than July 31, 2020, accompanied with the late compliance fee. Incomplete forms will be returned unprocessed. The Form 19 can be mailed to the Supreme Court of Ohio, with a check made payable to the Supreme Court of Ohio; or may email the Form 19 to LateCompliance@sc.ohio.gov and request to pay the late compliance fee by credit card. Any late compliance forms sent by email must be received by July 31, 2020, 11:59 p.m. ET.
