Temporary Orders in Response to the COVID-19, Coronavirus

Effective date March 17, 2020


Upon the Court's own motion, and to ensure the safety and protection of the community, in response to Executive Order 2020-01D, by the Governor Mike DeWine, declaring a State of Emergency in the State of Ohio, the Medina County Probate Court shall forthwith implement case management orders intended to protect the public health and safety of all citizens, maintain the essential functions of the court, while protecting the rights of all litigants.

The Court hereby implements the following Temporary Orders in Response to the COVID-19 Coronavirus for thirty (30) days,

1. Any and all hearings on accounts and inventories will be considered on the written filings only. The parties shall not appear for the hearing. If a party files written exceptions or requests to appear in person for the hearing, the Court will either schedule a pretrial or continue the case for a hearing at a later date.
