
ENTRY

This cause is pending before the court as a jurisdictional appeal.

Upon consideration of appellee's motion to designate appellant a vexatious litigator, it is ordered by the court that the motion is granted and Timothy Workman is found to be a vexatious litigator under S.Ct.Prac.R. 4.03(B). Accordingly, it is ordered that Timothy Workman is prohibited from continuing or instituting legal proceedings in this court without first obtaining leave. Any request for leave shall be submitted to the clerk of this court by delivery service, by mail addressed to the Clerk of the Supreme Court, or in person for the court's review.

It is further ordered that upon consideration of the jurisdictional memoranda filed in this case, the court declines to accept jurisdiction of the appeal pursuant to S.Ct.Prac.R. 7.08(B)(4).
