 a. Durability (will the agreement work after mediation?) Who was not at the mediation session and can support the agreement or interfere with the agreement? b. Clarity c. Any overlooked issues d. Flexibility/Balance e. Self-Determination
Notify the mediator with any changes or additions to the DRAFT agreement (740) 355-8368 The mediator will make changes and redistribute copies to all parties.
If parties need to schedule another mediation session to clarify or further customize their understanding, please call (740) 355-8368.
When the DRAFT agreement is ready to be submitted to court, determine which attorney will be responsible for preparing an Entry, Qualified Domestic Relations Order or other legal material.
Attorneys may request a DRAFT agreement be forwarded to their office by e-mail to facilitate the completion of an agreed entry.
After the Agreed Entry has been prepared to the satisfaction of all parties and their attorneys, file a request for a hearing date to the appropriate court.
After the judge approves the entry, the Clerk of Court will be instructed to mail a file-stamped copy to all parties and attorneys of record
