A VEXATIOUS LITIGATOR

This matter came on for case management and defendant's Motion to Dismiss on September 18, 2006. Defendant's Motion to Dismiss was granted by the Court. The Court further finds that Plaintiff, Preston Buschard is a vexatious litigator within the meaning of Ohio Revise Code 2323.52(A)(3). As to litigation concerning the State of Ohio and Hamilton County as a vexatious litigator the Plaintiff Preston Buschard is prohibited by this Court pursuant to Ohio Revised Code 2323.52(D)(1)(a)-(c) from:

- (a) Instituting legal proceeding in the court of claims or in a court of common pleas, municipal court or county court, involving the State of Ohio or Hamilton County;
- (b) Continuing any legal proceeding that the vexatious litigator had instituted in the court of claims or in a court of common pleas, municipal court, or in county court involving the State of Ohio or Hamilton County;
- (c) Making any application, other than an application for leave to proceed under division (f) of this section, in any legal proceedings involving the State of Ohio or

Hamilton County instituted by the vexatious litigator or another person in the
