97-997. Corporate Exchange Bldg. IV & V, L.P. v. Franklin Cty. Bd. of Revision.

Board of Tax Appeals, No. 95-A-465. This cause is pending before the court as an appeal from the Board of Tax Appeals.

IT IS ORDERED by the court, sua sponte, that the order striking appellees' brief entered September 18, 1997, is hereby vacated.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED by the court, sua sponte, that appellant may file a reply brief within twenty days of the date of this order.

97-1681. Lane v. Cincinnati Civ. Serv. Comm.

Hamilton App. No. C-960698. This cause is pending before the court as a discretionary appeal and cross-appeal and claimed appeal of right.

IT IS ORDERED by the court, sua sponte, that appellees/cross-appellants shall file an original and ten copies of their combined memorandum in response and in support of cross-appeal, originally filed September 10, 1997, without the duplicate memorandum in support of jurisdiction included in the earlier filing.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED by the court, sua sponte, that the appellant/cross-appellee shall have thirty days from the date the corrected memorandum is filed to file a memorandum in response to the cross-appeal.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED by the court, sua sponte, that the corrected memorandum in response and in support of cross-appeal shall be filed within seven days of the date of this entry.

MISCELLANEOUS DISMISSALS

97-1951. State v. Salyer.

Hamilton App. No. C-960697. This cause is pending before the court as a discretionary appeal. On September 15, 1997, appellant filed a memorandum in support of jurisdiction that exceeded the page limit. Whereas S.Ct.Prac.R. III(1)(C)

prohibits the filing of a memorandum in support of jurisdiction that exceeds fifteen pages,

IT IS ORDERED by the court, sua sponte, that appellant's memorandum in support of jurisdiction be, and hereby is, stricken.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED by this court that this cause be, and hereby is, dismissed.
