MOTION AND PROCEDURAL RULINGS

2005-1432. In re Guardianship of Schneider.

Medina App. No. 05CA0050-M. This cause is pending before the court as an appeal from the Court of Appeals for Medina County. Upon consideration of appellant's motion to vacate the order issued February 27, 2006 and motion for leave to hear all matters in this case en banc,

IT IS ORDERED by the court that the motions are denied.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED by the court that appellant is prohibited from filing additional documents in this appeal, and the Clerk of this court shall refuse to file any additional documents tendered for filing in this case by appellant.

2005-1652. In re Guardianship of Schneider.

Medina App. No. 05CA0050-M. This cause is pending before the court as an appeal from the Court of Appeals for Medina County. Upon consideration of appellant's motion to vacate the order issued February 27, 2006 and motion for leave to hear all matters in this case en banc,

IT IS ORDERED by the court that the motions are denied.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED by the court that appellant is prohibited from filing additional documents in this appeal, and the Clerk of this court shall refuse to file any additional documents tendered for filing in this case by appellant.

Lorain App. No. 04CR065248. This cause is pending before the court as a death penalty appeal from the Lorain County Court of Common Pleas. Upon consideration of appellant's motion for an extension of time to transmit the record,

IT IS ORDERED by the court that the motion is granted, and the time for transmitting the record is extended to April 17, 2006.

DISCIPLINARY CASES

2005-1329. In re Resignation of Michele Auge' Alvaro.

IT IS ORDERED by this court, sua sponte, that Michele Auge' Alvaro, Attorney Registration No. 0065059, last known business address in Cincinnati, Ohio, is found in contempt for failure to comply with this court's order of October 4, 2005, to wit: failure to file an affidavit of compliance on or before November 3, 2005.

2005-1674. State v. Marlin.

Cuyahoga App. No. 84399, 2005-Ohio-3691. This cause is pending before the court as an appeal and cross-appeal from the Court of Appeals for Cuyahoga County. Upon consideration of the joint application for dismissal,

IT IS ORDERED by the court that the application for dismissal is granted. Accordingly, this cause is dismissed.

This matter originated in this court on the filing of a report by the Commission on Continuing Legal Education ("commission") pursuant to Gov.Bar R. X(6)(A)(1)(b) and (A)(2)(d). The commission recommended the imposition of sanctions against certain attorneys, including the above-named respondent, for failure to comply with the provisions of Gov.Bar R. X, Attorney Continuing Legal Education, for the 2003-2004 reporting period.
